

Tennis & Social Privilege 2020 Season

Manchester Country Club is pleased to offer a Tennis & Social Privilege for the 2020 season. In addition to play on 2 professional quality clay courts, a Tennis & Social privilege holder is welcome to use the Club's restaurant facilities and attend social events. Our tennis program itself offers open play, group clinics and private lessons from our MCC pro and organized matches and tournaments. If tennis is not your primary interest, the MCC Tennis & Social Privilege offers full access to the Club for card playing and other social pursuits providing the ability to enjoy the amenities of private country club life.

Our restaurant, The Beech, offers an outdoor dining patio with picturesque views of the front nine, a casual bar area, and a formal dining space. Recently MCC added an overlook patio, complete with a fire pit, with full view of the 9th and 18th green. The Overlook is a great spot to watch some golf action while enjoying a cocktail after a tennis match or card game. For tennis players the MCC Tennis & Social Privilege offers a quality program and the bonus of a private club experience. For those with primarily social interests, the privilege provides a full access to all of our clubhouse offerings.

Privilege Overview

- Unlimited use of the Club's 2 clay tennis courts for casual and tournament play
- Ability to host tennis guests at MCC for nominal court fees
- Access to private tennis lessons from MCC's tennis professional
- Ability to participate in complimentary group clinics conducted by the tennis professional
- Full access to the MCC dining room for card & game playing
- Unlimited use of MCC's restaurant, the Beech, which is open for lunch daily during the tennis season and has regularly scheduled dinner nights based on the Club calendar.
- Welcome at all dining & social functions Opening Cocktail Party, Clam & Lobster Bakes, Fall Harvest Dinner...and more!
- Full charging privileges to a Club account
- Ability to host private events using the Club's facilities (The Club is available to privilege holders to host cocktail parties, family gatherings, rehearsal dinners, weddings, etc.)

Privilege Limitations & Notes

- No ability to use the golf course is offered within the Tennis & Social Privilege
- For a Single Tennis & Social privilege holder, clubhouse access for card/game playing by a spouse requires purchase of a Family Tennis & Social Privilege
- Guests for card/game playing are allowed up to 5 times per season
- Tennis & Social Privilege holders will not own stock or have voting rights at MCC
 Privilege holders are also asked to support our traditional Employee Appreciation Fund through a onetime end of season contribution to recognize the services provided by all staff members during the year
- Prospective privilege holder applications will be reviewed by the Membership Committee and approved by the Board of Directors. MCC reserves the right to reject an individual's application for participation in the program.
- Family includes spouse and children under 18
- Privilege dues are subject to VT sales tax
